The goal of this professional development course is to provide local and state-level emergency responders with an overview of key duties and responsibilities of a Safety Officer within the ICS structure and specifically for a Type III All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT)

Preferred Trainees

- Preferred participants include, but are not limited to, those who are working towards being credentialed as a Safety Officer on a Type 3 IMT and those looking to act as a Safety Officer on Type 5 or Type 4 incidents.
- Training seats are limited to 20 participants on a first come first serve basis.
- A minimum of 12 participants is required 2 weeks prior to class start date or the class will be cancelled.
