Hazard Mitigation Assistance makes federal funds available to states, US territories, Indian tribal governments, local governments, special districts, and eligible non-profits to implement mitigation activities. Hazard Mitigation Assistance grants may fund 75 percent of eligible project costs and require at least 25 percent local match.
