Overview:

This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities and capabilities of an effective PSC on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AJIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories:

2. Effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an Incident Commander on an All-Hazards ICS Incident and Incident Management Team.

Exercises, simulations, discussions and a final exam enable the students to process and apply their new knowledge.
