

ALL HAZARDS INCIDENT COMMANDER COURSE

Course Overview: This Course is designed to provide locals and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of a Type III Incident Commander.

These responsibilities fall into two categories:

- 1) Responding to the incident and command needs of the incident, and
- 2) Effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of Incident Commander on an All-Hazards ICS Incident Management Team.

Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their knowledge.

Prerequisites: Completion of IS-100, IS-200, ICS 300, ICS-400, IS 700, and IS-800.
