## Management of Spontaneous Volunteers in Disasters

**Overview:** This course aims to introduce managing large numbers of spontaneous volunteers in disasters. In disasters, volunteer help is needed, and with basic Emergency Management coordination skills, the volunteer resources can often be put to effective use, making a positive difference in the affected community.

The course will discuss the benefits spontaneous volunteers can bring to relief efforts and the challenges they may bring if not coordinated effectively. In addition, the course will examine planning considerations regarding spontaneous volunteers. Special emphasis is also placed on how to make full use of a Volunteer Reception Center.
