FEMA-4225-NE Declaration

- Federal Disaster declaration on June 25, 2015 for the May 6, 2015 thru June 17, 2015 Severe Storms, Tornadoes, Straight-line winds and Flooding.
- Public Assistance and 406 Mitigation in the declared counties of Cass, Dundy, Gage, Jefferson, Lincoln, Lancaster, Morrill, Nuckolls, Otoe Saline, Saunders & Thayer
- (In the first request– more to follow.)

404 Mitigation grant funding available State Wide for hazard mitigation plan updates and projects for all eligible sub-applicants.

Eligible sub-applicants include State agencies, local governments, communities, and Private non-profit organizations. The Tribal governments may apply as an applicant or sub-applicant.

HMGP Applicant Instructions:

- ◇ Send Letter of Intent to apply for HMGP funding to NEMA's Hazard Mitigation Office @ email addresses on the left panel.

Complete the HMGP application for submission to NEMA and potentially FEMA for sub-grant processing.

- ◇ Obtain any necessary permits or approval letters from Environmental & Historic Preservation agencies.

Complete Benefit Cost Analysis for regular projects as needed.
