Overview:

This offering is a four day course, designed for all local, regional, tribal, and state/territory emergency response professionals and for support personnel with a communications background. It is designed to familiarize these professionals with the roles and responsibilities of a Communications Unit Leader (COML) under the NIMS ICS and to provide hands-on exercises that reinforce the lecture materials. Under the NIMS ICS structure, the COML is the focal point within the Communications Unit. This course provides DHS-approved and NIMS-compliant instruction to ensure that every state/territory has trained personnel capable of coordinating on-scene emergency communications during a multi-jurisdictional response or planned event.

Prerequisites:

- A public safety background with experience in field operations
- Attendees need to have technical communications background for this class
- Awareness of fundamental public safety communications technology
- Basic knowledge of the local, regional, tribal, and State Communications Plan/points of contact
- Completion of IS-100.c, IS-200.c, IS-700.b, and IS-800.d
- Completion of ICS-300.b
- Completion of ICS-400 is recommended
